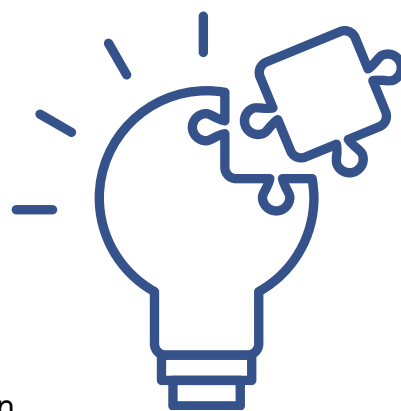
Path to Success

Path to Success is an engaging **Employment Skills Program** created specifically by Together We Can International for neurodivergent participants in our community ready to explore employment, build confidence, and take practical steps towards their future.

What Makes Path to Success Different?

Created by experts in disability employment and neuro-inclusive practice, our Path to Success curriculum has been carefully adapted to support maximum engagement for neurodivergent young people.

Replacing traditional delivery methods with short, interactive modules, hands-on activities, and flexible, strength-based learning. All designed to keep participants actively involved, comfortable, and connected throughout the program, delivered in a supportive group setting, encouraging peer connection, confidence, and real-world conversation



How long does it go for?

Delivered in two dynamic 10-week blocks once a week, this program acts as a boot camp for employment readiness. Equipping young people with the skills, knowledge, and support they need to make the transition from school to the workplace with practical tools to explore with confidence.

Who can join?

Path to Success is open to all neurodivergent young people in our community, including school leavers, NDIS participants, and self-funded individuals or organisations looking for structured support to bridge the gap between education and employment.

We also proudly partner with employment service providers, schools, and community organisations offering a collaborative, dual-service model that enhances outcomes and ensures young people are surrounded by a connected, wraparound support network.

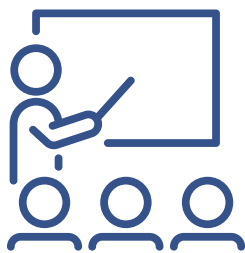

Who can join?

Insight Days are open to everyone in the community, neurodivergent young people, school leavers, NDIS participants, self-funded individuals, and those supported by community or employment service providers. You can attend as many or as few as you like — each day is a new opportunity to discover, engage, and grow.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Who can attend?

Anyone! Our Employment programs are open to any neurodivergent young people aged 15+

How much is it?

Programs are charged per session or in blocks of 6 at a discounted rate. Session prices vary depending on the complexity of the day and the location of where it is

Do I need to be on NDIS?

Not at all. If you think these sessions would be beneficial to you or someone you know, support or work with, but don't have a formal diagnosis or NDIS plan, that does not rule you out.

How do I book or get more information?

You can either send an enquiry directly through the contact us page of our website OR call our Employer Engagement Team on (08) 8164 6991 and ask about our Group Programs

Can I get my School or Employment Provider to contact you?

Absolutely, we work with many schools and a number of Workforce Australia providers to deliver Industry insights, and we bill them directly.

Do I need a support worker to attend with me?

Not necessarily. We provide mentor support during the day, but participants are welcome to bring their own support if preferred.

Is Transport Included?

Yes, we offer safe, tracked transport through our TWCI vehicle fleet that picks you up and drops you off at the conclusion of the day, depending on your location this is included in the price.

What Industries are involved?

Industries vary but often include hospitality, retail, trades, creative arts, gaming, manufacturing, horticulture, animal rescue, logistics, and more, all hosted by inclusive, disability-friendly employers.

Can participants get a job from attending?

Absolutely. We've seen many young people offered interviews or further opportunities simply by showing up, asking questions, and showing interest.

What do I wear?

Clean, smart casual attire with closed in shoes for safety.
